

MCC Kids Safety Plan

Here is our plan to keep kids safe and care for them as part of our church family on Sunday mornings:

Supervision: There will be 2 staff members or volunteers with children in the designated children's areas at all times. They will fill out an application and undergo a background check and orientation. If a teenager is helping, an adult will supervise them.

Bathroom: Parents should take kids to the bathroom *before* they are dropped off at their classroom.

Nursery Sign in/Sign out: Parents need to sign in their child during nursery drop off.

Allergies: Should be noted by parents on the sign-in form.

First Aid: Band-aids are available in a container in the nursery. If a child complains of feeling sick, or needs first aid other than a band-aid, we will take them to their parents.

Fire Alarm: Should the fire alarm go off, kids in the nursery room will exit with their supervisors out the door through the exit door across the nursery entrance. Supervisors and kids will move away from the building to a safe distance, and wait for the parents to meet them once they exit from the sanctuary. If there is a class meeting in the Sunday School classrooms, they will come down the hall and exit through the side door.

Earthquake: In the event of an earthquake, kids and supervisors should shelter as best they can and try to keep the kids calm, then follow procedure for Fire Alarm.

Shelter in Place: Supervisors in the nursery should take kids and Sunday School classrooms should attempt to block the doors and keep children away from doors and windows in event of an "active shooter" lockdown.
